PASTOR RUSSELL

The death of Charles Taze Russell of Brooklyn, N. Y., on October 31, 1916, is a matter of more than ordinary interest for many seasons. "Pastor" Russell, as he was familiarly known by both of his friends and his enemies, was an independent Bible student, writer, lecturer, preacher, well known the wide world around.
